Presidents Report

March 2015

Hi,

This month has been very proud one for the Club and I would like to congratulate all those members who participated towards Mt Gravatt becoming **QLACCA Lapidary Club of the Year for 2014**.

QLACCA for the first time has split the Lapidary Prizes of the year for members into 5 sections to reflect better what crafts are represented and encourage more participation. Mt Gravatt won 2 out of the 5 sections.

We can boast that we have **QLACCA Lapidrist of the Year for 2014** (highest number of points encompassing all sections) and winner of the **Lapidary of the year 2014 for Group 5**, (Mineral/Casting section) as well as another 4 members in the top 10. Congratulations go to all Members. The announcement of the winners was made at North Brisbane Show on the 7th March and our trophies will be donated at the annual show in May.

Thank you must go to Graham Kinsela for visiting our members on the 17/3/2015 giving an informative discussion on the Australian Facetors Guild and faceting in general. He was sorry about the short notice and has promised to return again. He has also agreed to demonstrate at the annual show. Minsoc have agreed to display at the show and to Robert Ross has agreed to demonstrate at the show many thanks to them. An invitation has been sent to Krista Adams asking her to present the trophies at the show.

We have replaced the 60/80 Sinted wheel this week because it had been abused and sent out of round by certain members exerting too much pressure in certain places on the wheel. We ask that all members are diligent in the proper use of the wheels and in reporting problems to the instructors and the instructors are diligent in reprimanding the people responsible. Wheels are a major cost to the club.

The BCC has extended the lease on the existing land for another 4 years and have approved in principle to the application for another 485 square meters of land (the same area as the existing lease) paperwork is still to be done and signed sealed and delivered.

We have been fortunate to have had three donations of rock in this month with some very nice specimens and an old faceting machine that will go up for tender at a later date. Thanks to Max and David for their assistance in sorting the rock. It will be put on sale in the club gradually when it is slabbed sorted and priced.

Thank you to Max and David all the water taps in the Cabbing room have been replaced and refurbished. The external drains have all been cleaned and unblocked.

George will be back at the club on the 18th of April. Although it's too late for our competition, he always has a good selection of faceting and cabbing material. He's also bringing a new selection of agate from overseas this time.

Things are moving along in the faceting room too with several beginners currently being taught. While on the subject of the faceting room, there have been several examples of misuse of the machines. The following should be adhered to:

No repairs. Find the duty instructor and report it.

Also, the faceting machines are not to be used for fixing the backs of cabs, sharpening aluminium pencils or sanding silver.

ACCIDENT AND INCIDENT INSURANCE

There has been some concern in the club in regard to the age that is covered by this insurance. The policy has come in from QLACCA and Members from 8 to 95 are all now covered by this insurance. Apparently some years in the past this has not been the case hence the confusion.

INSURANCE FOR FIELD TRIPS

Only Members are covered by the club's ACCIDENT & INCIDENT cover arranged by QLACCA. When your name is registered you must also register the registration number of the vehicle the member is travelling in.

Friends and family members are welcome but they are not covered by the club insurance.

COMPUTER

The club office computer has had problems for some time. The meeting made the decision to purchase a computer for the Secretary and have the office computer stripped out and rebuilt. Please be aware that while the office computer is being repaired it will not be available at the clubhouse.

EQUIPMENT

There are new templates in the cabbing rooms this month.

The VJ faceting machine has returned from being serviced.

SINTERED WHEELS

The 60 Sintered wheel was replaced this week. It is clear that this wheel had been abused!!! This abuse has shortened the life of this wheel by up to 6 months. Instructors will now be watching member carefully on all equipment including the sintered wheels. Any member who is abusing the wheels will be cautioned and if this abuse continues maybe asked to leave the session. Abuse of this wheel includes pressing too hard, working on the side of the wheel and only working in the middle of the wheel.

Each sintered wheel costs the club \$370.
