ALL MEMBERS - GENERAL INFORMATION

- The Duty Instructor is in charge at all times while the club rooms are open, all members are expect to follow the directions given by the duty instructor.
- There will be no work commenced until at least 2 persons are in the club house.
- The Duty officer is the Management Committee representative if a Committee Member is not on premises.
- The field trip officer is in charge at all times and responsible while on a field trip (refer to field trip rules).
- A First-Aid box is available in the office and the First-Aid station is in the kitchen.
- Adequate ventilation is required at all times while the clubrooms is occupied.
- The doors are to be unlocked as they are the emergency exits.
- On arrival, please sign in and pay appropriate fees.
- Before you use any piece of equipment, the first time, please ensure you ask the instructor to demonstrate how to use it.
- If you damage equipment please report it to the duty instructor (we know accidents happen)
- Members are required to clean the clubrooms at the end of each session. Check the appropriate area instructions for what is to be done.
- Any member found repeatedly misbehaving or breaking the club rules maybe asked to leave the premises by the duty instructor or management committee.

PERSONAL SAFETY

- Closed footwear must be worn at all times.
- Long hair must be secured behind the head not just in a ponytail.
- No loose clothing.
- Remove jewellery – both for safety reasons and as it can easily be damaged by the machinery

SAFETY OF OTHERS

- No smoking rules are as per government regulations.
- No horseplay permitted on the premises.
- No electrical repairs to equipment are to be attempted. All faults to be reported to the duty instructor.
- All gas torches are to be refilled outside.

It is the responsibility of all members to ensure they know the not only the general rules but the rules of each craft they are undertaking. These can be found on the website, at the front office or ask the duty instructor.

MEMBERSHIP CONDITIONS

JUNIOR MEMBERS

- Upon arrival at the clubhouse all Junior's must make themselves known to the Duty Instructor.
- Junior members between the ages of 10-12 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian when on premises.
- Junior members may not leave the premises unless accompanied by a parent or elected guardian.

VISITORS

- Visitors are to sign in.
- Upon arrival at the club all visitor's must make themselves known to the duty instructor.
- Visitors Badges are supplied please wear one.
- Visitors must be supervised by another member at all times and must wear closed footwear, glasses and ear protection as per the club standards.
- Visitors cannot use the equipment.
- No animals allowed in the clubhouse during sessions
