## TAILGATING & STALL HOLDER

### TERMS & CONDITIONS

---

Tailgaters/Tailgating traditionally refers to the selling of goods from the back of a vehicle which is how trading at many gem shows originated. The term Tailgaters also extends to stall holders who set up a stall with goods displayed on tables and stands under the protection of a gazebo/canopy with or without reference to a vehicle.

By submitting a completed application for Tailgating at the Mt Gravatt Lapidary Gem Show (The Event), Tailgaters are indicating acceptance of the Terms and Conditions of the Mt Gravatt Lapidary Society Inc (The Society) by themselves and any person(s) working for/representing them at The Event. Tailgaters agree to abide by the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The gates will open to Tailgaters at 5:30am on the day of the event (Saturday, May 25, 2019). All Tailgaters to be onsite by 7:00am.** The Show opens to the public from 8am.
2. Tailgaters will register at the gate on the day, and trade within the times and areas allotted to them by The Society.
3. Tailgaters acknowledge that the venue is a park and therefore an open air space and that no refunds will be made due to weather conditions. Tailgaters must provide all weather protection for their allotted space. Tailgaters are responsible for securing structures within their allotted space, being mindful of safety for themselves, other stall holders and the public.
4. Tailgaters may only trade at The Event with the approval of The Society which will be given in the form of an official confirmation from the Gem Show Convenor or delegate. An application to Tailgate (including that with payment) does not entitle the Tailgater to trade.
5. Tailgaters agree to pay the stipulated fees upon application and before the stipulated cut off date (May 17<sup>th</sup> 2019). Payment in full is to accompany the Tailgating application.
6. Tailgaters must have Public Liability Insurance and must provide a copy of that insurance to The Society with submission of the Tailgating application.
7. Tailgaters attend The Event at the discretion of The Society who have the right to refuse entry or eject a Tailgater for behaviour likely to cause damage, injury, nuisance, or for failure to comply with reasonable requests. Those evicted will not be re-admitted to The Event either as a Tailgater or by general admission. The Society reserves the right not to grant admission to an evicted Tailgater to future events.
8. Tailgaters will not knowingly impart false facts or information, or defraud, or mislead the public by presenting non genuine facts and items for sale.
